We appreciate your patience and flexibility as we navigate through this post-pandemic journey together. You all have done a wonderful job in adhering to the guidelines that were put in place by our *Return to Worship Team*. We are modifying our guidelines in accordance with the CDC. As we move forward with caution, items 3, 4, 5 and 14 have been updated.

1. If you are a part of our vulnerable population (seniors or those with pre-existing medical conditions) it is highly recommended that you stay home and participate in our virtual worship and study opportunities.
2. If you are sick or have symptoms please stay home until you are cleared to return.
- *3. When you are ready to come to worship and you are fully vaccinated, please continue to wear a facemask. Once you are seated, you may remove your mask or pull it down as you are comfortable.**
- *4. If you are not fully vaccinated, we ask that you wear your mask throughout the entire service.**
- *5. We will no longer be checking temperatures nor requiring you to sign-in.**
6. Hand sanitizer will be available as well as extra disposable face coverings.
7. You must maintain social distance while in the building. .
8. There can be no lingering or socializing. Please refrain from handshakes and hugging.
9. Our ushers will guide you to assigned seating areas. Please be cooperative and flexible; realizing during this time, you will not be seated in your "usual" section. The seating procedure we have adopted calls for seating worshippers from front to back to avoid contact and passing by others.
10. Husband and wife and persons within the same household or those you are comfortable with may sit together.
11. Restroom facilities are open on both levels.
12. At the end of service, you will be guided and dismissed by the ushers. Everyone will exit on Pershing Ave.
13. There will be a basket as you exit to place your tithes/offerings and prayer requests.
- *14. Van transportation will resume in August.**
