We are excited as we plan to gather in Worship on **April 4, 2021**, Resurrection Sunday! We will have two services, **8:00 AM and 11:30 AM**. Please note the change of time of our second service to allow for sanitizing. Each service will be about one hour and fifteen minutes.

We want to take this time to say thank you for your patience, love, prayers, and continued support through the pandemic. We are grateful for the progress that has been made with increased vaccination availability and the decrease in the number of cases in York County. We shall continue to navigate with caution, but we can boldly declare that God is faithful!

Our leaders have worked diligently to make sure policies are in place and that proper equipment and supplies have been purchased for the safety of our worshippers upon our return to in-person worship.

We are looking forward to worshipping together!

Our expectations of you...

- If you are a part of our vulnerable population (seniors or those with pre-existing medical conditions) it is highly recommended that you stay home and take part in our virtual worship and study opportunities. Note: The 11:30 AM service (ONLY) will be streamed Live on Facebook.
- If you are sick, or have Covid-19, or flu symptoms, please stay home until you are cleared to return.
- When you are ready to come for worship, it is required to wear a face mask throughout the entire service (unless you are a designated speaker). The service will be approximately one hour and fifteen minutes.
- Please use the S. Pershing Ave. entrance ONLY to enter the church. Upon entering the building on S. Pershing Ave., you will be guided to the lounge area for a temperature screening. Your temperature must be below 100.5 °F to enter.
- Hand sanitizer will be available as well as extra disposable face coverings.
- You must maintain a six-foot distance from the person in front of you and behind you.

- There can be no lingering or socializing. Please refrain from handshakes and hugging.
- Our ushers will guide you to assigned seating areas. Please be cooperative and flexible; realizing during this time, you will not be seated in your “usual” section. The seating procedure we have adopted calls for seating worshippers from front to back to avoid contact and passing by others. Spouses and persons within the same household may sit together.
- Restrooms will be open and can be used one at a time. Ushers will direct you.
- At the end of service, you will be guided and dismissed by the ushers. Please remain seated and follow their lead.

General Information...

- There will be a basket at the exit to place your tithes/offerings and prayer requests.
- At this time, Children’s Church will not be available.
- The CornerStore is closed until further notice.
- Van transportation will not be provided at this time.
- The door on Cottage Place (alley entrance) will be designated for wheelchair accessibility and for CBC staff members.
